# DESCRIPTION:

Cleanaderm cream contain combination of Betamethasone Valerate. Gentamicin Sulfate, Tolnaftate & Iodochlorhydroxyguinoline (clioguinol). Cleanaderm cream is commonly used for Fungal infections. Itch or rash. Atopic dermatitis, Skin infections,

# PHARMACODYNAMICS:

Topical Anti-infectives with Corticosteroids.

Mechanism of Action: Cleanaderm cream is a combination of the antiinflammatory, antipruritic and vasoconstrictive agent betamethasone valerate, the wide-spectrum antibiotic gentamicin sulfate, the fungicidal agent tolnaftate and cliquinol an antibacterial and antifungal agent.

#### PHARMACOKINETICS:

Clioquinol: Topical absorption is rapid and extensive, especially when the skin is covered with an occlusive dressing or if the medication is applied to extensive or eroded areas of the skin. Clioquinol is absorbed through the skin in sufficient amounts to affect thyroid function tests. Gentamicin (as sulfate): Systemic absorption of gentamicin have been reported after topical use on denuded skin and burns.

Betamethasone (as Valerate): Betamethasone when applied topically. particularly under an occlusive dressing when the skin is broken. sufficient corticosteroids may be absorbed to give systemic effects. It is metabolized in the liver and distributed throughout body tissues: crosses the placenta and enters the breast milk. Excretion is via urine.

## INDICATION:

## DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Method of administration: Topical As directed by the Physician.

#### CONTRAINDICATION:

Hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients. Contraindicated to patients with tuberculous lesions of the skin, acute herpes simplex, vaccine or varicella. Avoid use in or near the eyes. The

safety of use in pregnant females has not been absolutely established. Therefore, they should not be used extensively on pregnant patients, in large amounts or for prolonged period of time.

INTERACTION WITH OTHER MEDICINE AND CONCOMITANT USE: Cleanaderm cream may interact with Amikacin, Aminoglutethimide. Amphotericin B. Anticholinesterases, Antidiabetics, Barbiturates, Carbamazepine, Cephaloridine, Cephalosporins, Cholestyramine,

# PREGNANCY AND LACTATION:

The safety of use in pregnant females has not been absolutely established. Therefore, they should not be used extensively on pregnant patients, in large amounts or for prolonged period of time.

Irritation, itching, burning, maceration of the skin. Photosensitization, allergy.
